Vaccines for children will be available at all immunization clinics. Please bring child's immunization records. A flat fee of \$15.00 is requested per child, however, no one is turned away due to an inability to pay. Adults should have a Tetanus booster every ten years. People born after 1957 are urged to have a second Measles immunization. Senior citizens and people with chronic disease are encouraged to get the Pneumonia vaccine. Adult immunizations are available by appointment. The CDC recommends the HPV vaccine be given to girls/women between 9 and 26 years of age. We can provide the HPV vaccine to women 18 years old and younger. A vaccine to protect against shingles is also available.
