Vaccines for children will be available at all immunization clinics. Please bring child's immunization records. A flat fee of \$15.00 is requested per child, however, no one is turned away due to an inability to pay. Adults should have a Tetanus booster every ten years. People born after 1957 are urged to have a second Measles immunization. Senior citizens are encouraged to get the Pneumonia vaccine. Adult immunizations are available by appointment. The CDC recommends the HPV vaccine be given to girls/women between 9 and 26 years of age. We can provide the HPV vaccine to women 18 years old and younger.
